

Instructions to visitors

The hotel is Sokos hotel Presidentti. The address of the hotel is Eteläinen Rautatiekatu 4, Helsinki, and the telephone number is + 358-20-1234608.

You can get to the hotel by taxi from the airport or you can take a bus to the city center, next to the railway station, (busses number 615 and 615V and Finnair City Bus) *, see: http://www.finnair.com/finnaircom/wps/wcm/resources/file/ebf1760126ea0fa/FINNAIR_CITY_BUS_TIMETABLE.pdf
It takes only couple of minutes to walk to the hotel from the railway station.

HECER offices are opposite the hotel in a building called Economicum. If you stand in front of the hotel, the Economicum building is across, slightly to the left. It is a 4-floor red-brick building. On the right of Economicum there's an older building, with a statue of a moose in front of it (the building is the museum of natural history).

*By bus

Finnair City Bus: Airport - Helsinki city centre, fare 5,90 €

Busses number 615 and 615V: Airport – Helsinki city centre, fare 4,00 €

In the city center the Finnair City Bus is next to the railway station building (square called Elielinaukio) and the bus stop for the bus number 615 is also next to the railway station but on the other side of the building (square called Rautatientori). It takes only couple of minutes to walk to the hotel from the railway station.

*By taxi

The taxi journey from the airport to the centre of Helsinki takes nearly half an hour and costs about 30 €.

There are taxi stations right outside the Arrivals Halls of the Domestic and International terminals. Service desks for the taxi operators can be found at Arrivals halls 1 and 2.
